## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow gas leak repair works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in the parking bay outside Nos.213-227 Brixton Road.

  The Order will be effective from 12:01 AM 14th March 2021 until 11:59 PM 4th April2021 or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall
- from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

  4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:

  (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
  - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
    (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction or a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
