ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3204 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named, Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas connection works to take place on A3204 Kennington Lane.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any westbound vehicle from turning right into Vauxhall Street from Kennington Lane.
 The Order will be effective from 08:00 AM on 5th April 2021 until 06:00 PM on 10th April 2021 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Courtenay Road, Sandcroft Street and Newburn Street to normal route of travel or via Loughborough Street and Newburn Street to normal route of travel or via Durham Street, Harleyford Road, Kennington Lane, Tyers Street and Jonathan Street to normal route of travel.
