ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANES) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place on the A2 New Cross Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on New Cross Road between its junctions with Alpha Road and Florence Road.

The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the westbound bus lane on New Cross Road between its junctions with Alpha Road and Florence Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 8:00 AM on 29th March 2021 until 7:00 PM on 5th April 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
