ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROADS (STANSTEAD ROAD/ CATFORD HILL/ CATFORD ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place on the A205 Catford Hill.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on A205 Stanstead Road/Catford Hill/Catford Road eastbound between the junctions of Glenwood Road and Ravensbourne Park;
 - (2) entering or proceeding on A205 Catford Road/Catford Hill westbound between the junctions of Rushey Green and Stanstead Road, local access will be maintained between Rushey Green and Ravensbourne Park;
 - (3) entering or proceeding on A212 Catford Hill northbound between its junctions with Stanstead Road and A205 Stanstead Road.The Order will be effective at certain times between 4:30 AM on 4th April 2021 until 12:30 AM on 5th April 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via A212 Catford Hill, Perry Hill, Bell Green, Southend Lane, Bromley Road and Rushey Green or reverse to normal route of travel.
