## **Transport for London Notice**

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A205 GLA ROAD (TULSE HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on A205 Tulse Hill.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle (except vehicles exceeding the height of 4.1 metres) from turning right into Norwood Road from Tulse Hill.
  - The Order will be effective from 10:00 PM on 12th March 2021 until 5:00 AM on 15th March 2021 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Thurlow Park Road and Croxted Road to normal route of travel.
