ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (YORK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow works to take place on A3200 York Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from any vehicle to entering, exiting or proceeding on A3200 York Road at its junctions

The Order will be effective between 11:00 PM on 15th March 2021 until 6:00 AM on 16th March 2021 or until the works has been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:

with Tenison Way and Waterloo Bridge

- (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via IMAX Roundabout, Waterloo Road, Baylis Road, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road, and Lambeth Palace Road, Westminster Bridge Road, Addington Street, York Road to normal route of travel.
