1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of a likelihood of danger to the public due to an increase in pedestrians

and pedal cyclists using certain roads following restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of

which will be to temporarily ban all vehicles, except pedal cycles, from entering that length of Prescott Place which lies between Clapham High Street and the common boundary of No. 114 Clapham High Street and St Peter's Church, Clapham Manor Street. Alternative routes for vehicles will be available for

affected vehicles via (i) Clapham High Street, Clapham Manor Street and Cresset Street and vice versa; and (ii) Clapham High Street, Stonhouse Street and Cresset Street and vice versa 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent

as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order will come into force on 1st April 2021 and will

continue until the 30th September 2021. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will have effect between 3 pm and 10 pm Monday to Sunday inclusive but if it is deemed necessary in the interest of public safety the Order may
