(a) ban vehicles from entering that length of:-Blairderry Road which lies between Barhill Road and Telford Avenue: (ii) Kirkstall Road which lies between Kirkstall Gardens and Telford Avenue: (iii) Telford Avenue which lies between Streatham Hill and Thornton Avenue:

the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

- (b) ban vehicles from entering, stopping or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) at any time in that length of:-
 - Farnan Road, which lies between Hopton Road and Polworth Road:
 - (ii) Hopton Road, between Streatham High Road and Streatham Common North:
 - (iii) Madeira Road, which lies between Gleneldon Road and Hopton Road;
- (iv) Oakdale, which lies between Madeira Road and Valley Road:
- (v) Polworth Road, which lies between Hopton Road and Rutford Road;
- (vi) Rutford Road, which lies between Hopton Road and Polworth Road
- 2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected
- by the bans described in paragraph 1 above, via adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs. 3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such
- extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order will come into force on 12th April 2021 and it
- will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the road closures and ban on stopping and waiting and loading will apply at different times and in phases as the works progress along the roads concerned and it is anticipated that it will take between 2 and 9 weeks to complete the works in each road.
