

# **LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM**

## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **The Lewisham (Southvale Road, SE3)**

#### **(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Southvale Road, SE3 between Tranquil Vale and Baizdon Road. (Note: The works are located at No.6 Southvale Road.) (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via either Tranquil Vale, Hare and Billet Road, Eliot Place and Baizdon Road, or Baizdon Road, Eliot Place, Hare and Billet Road, Tranquil Vale, Royal Parade, Montpelier Vale, Tranquil Vale and Southvale.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 26th April 2021 to remain in force for up to 2 months.
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
