ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A41 AND A501 GLA SIDE ROAD (ALLSOP PLACE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas main repair works to take place on the A41 GLA Side Road Allsop Place.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or proceeding on Allsop Place southbound between its junctions with Baker Street and Marylebone Road;
 - (2) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicle bays outside No.I Allsop Place.

The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the westbound bus lane on Marylebone Road between its junctions with Nottingham Place and Baker Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 12:01 AM on 10th April 2021 until 6:00 PM on 9th May 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Baker Street, York Street, Gloucester Place and Marylebone Road to normal route of travel.
