ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD AND GLA SIDE ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD AND COLDHARBOUR LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas mains replacement works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road GLA Side Road Coldharbour Lane.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning left from Acre Lane into Brixton Road;
 - (2) stopping at any time in the Loading Bay outside Nos. 506 to 508
 Brixton Road;
 - (3) stopping at any time in the Loading Bay on Coldharbour Lane south of No. 487 Brixton Road.

The Order will be effective at the weekends between 16th April 2021 and 26th April 2021. Phase one will take place each night from 9:00 PM on 16th April 2021 until 5:00 AM on 19th April 2021. Phase two will start from 9:00 PM on 23rd April 2021 until 5:00 AM on 24th May 2021, or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Effra Road, St Matthews Road and Brixton Hill and then to normal route of travel.
