ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow resurfacing works to take place on Edgware Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or
- proceeding on Edgware Road southbound between its junctions with the eastbound slip-road to Marylebone Road and Marble Arch, local access will be maintained between the eastbound slip-road to Marylebone Road and Seymour Street.

 The Order will be effective between 12th April 2021 and 22nd April 2021 every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Seymour Street and Great Cumberland Gate to normal route of travel. For HGVs via the eastbound slip-road to Marylebone Road, Marylebone Road, Baker Street, Portman Square, Orchard Street, North Audley Street, Grosvenor Square, Grosvenor Street and Park Lane to normal route of travel.
