ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (NEW KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable works to take place on the A201 New Kent Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping eastbound on New Kent Road between its junctions with Falmouth Road and Bricklayers Arms. Local access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 11th April 2021 and 30th April 2021 every night from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Newington Butts, Newington Causeway, Borough High Street, Great Dover Street to normal route of travel.
