1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving a crane operation to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban:

- (a) vehicles from entering that length of Renfrew Road which lies between the southeastern kerb-line of Kempsford Road and the north-western kerb-line of Dugard Way; and (b) pedestrians from entering that length of the footway
- which lies between the southeastern kerb-line of Kempsford Road and the south-eastern kerb-line of Dugard Way. 2. The road and footway closures will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the
- placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Kennington Lane, Durham Street, Harleyford Road, Kennington Lane, Kennington Road and Wincott Street: (ii)
- Kennington Lane, Newington Butts, Elephant & Castle, St George's Road, Lambeth Road and Kennington Road; and (iii) Wincott Street, Kempsford Road, Reedworth Street,

Kennington Road and Kennington Lane. 4. The Order will come into force on 19th May 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 7 am and 7 pm from 19th to 20th May 2021, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during
