## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### The Lewisham (Canonbie Road, SE23)

### (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Canonbie Road, SE23 between Honor Oak Road and Manor Way. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Honor Oak Road, Forest Hill Road and Netherby Road, and vice versa.
2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
3. The order comes into force on the 1st July 2021 to remain in force for up to 3 months. (Note: The works, and the closure, are planned to be in place between 19th and 23rd July 2021.)
4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
