Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Downham Lane, BR1)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** No parking/waiting between 8am and 6:30pm Monday to Friday in Downham Lane, BR1 on (i) the western side, between a point 1.7m north of the projected southern building line of 499 Bromley Road and a point 1.1m north of the projected common boundary of 479/477 Bromley Road, and (ii) the eastern side between a point 4.7m north of the projected common boundary of 479/477 Bromley Road and a point 20.35m northwards thereof.
- 2.** (1) Road closure in Downham Way between Medhurst Drive and Downham Way. (2) The alternative route for traffic affected by the prohibition is via Bromley Road and Downham Way. (Note: Any closure will be only for a few days to allow UKPN to carry out works in the highway. Date are unknown at present but advance notification will be given.)
- 3.** Suspension of the existing one way working in Downham Lane to allow access and egress.
- 4.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 5.** The order comes into force on the 1st July 2021 to remain in force for up to 6 months.
- 6.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
