ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES FOR

TELECOMMUNICATIONS WORKS BURNBURY ROAD, FIELDHOUSE ROAD, GLENFIELD ROAD, HAVERHILL ROAD AND RADBOURNE ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to modernise telecommunications equipment to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily impose a one-way system in:-

- (a) **Burnbury Road**, between Telferscot Road and Haverhill Road, in a south-westward direction;
- (b) **Fieldhouse Road**, the whole length in a north-westward direction;
- (c) **Glenfield Road**, the whole length, in a north-westward direction;
- (d) **Haverhill Road**, between Emmanuel Road and Burnbury Road, in a north-westward direction;
- (e) **Radbourne Road**, between Emmanuel Road and Burnbury Road, in a south-eastward direction.

2. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the restrictions described in paragraph 1 above, via adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs.

3. The one-way systems described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 6th September 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the one-way systems would only apply in phases as the works progress along the roads concerned and it is anticipated that the works would take between 2 and 3 weeks to complete in each road.
