 3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Gipsy Hill and Cawnpore Street and vice versa; and (b) Cawnpore Street, Gipsy Hill and Camden Hill Road and vice versa.

The Order will come into force on 31st August 2021 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in 3 phases and that the Order will only have effect at one of the locations specified in paragraph 1 of this Notice at a time, during the period specified in brackets next to each of those locations, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum duration of 6 months.
