**DEPTFORD PARKS LIVEABLE NEIGHBOURHOODS:  
EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF MOTOR  
VEHICLES – ROLT STREET**

The Lewisham (Prescribed routes) (No. 5) Experimental Traffic  
Order 2021

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council ('the Council') on 20th August 2021 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers of sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended. The Order will come into force on 27th August 2021 and will expire on 27th August 2023.

2. The general effect of the Order will be, by way of an experiment, to prohibit all motor vehicles from entering into or proceeding in ROLT STREET, between a point 10 metres west from No. 111 Rolt Street up to the junction with Woodpecker Road;

3. The Order provides that in pursuance of section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, the Council's Service Group Manager, Highways and Transport, or some person authorised by them, may, if it appears to them or that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Orders extends, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.

5. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

6. The Council will in due course consider whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely by means of a permanent Order made under section 6 of the 1984 Act. Any person may object to or make representations regarding the making of the permanent Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of six months beginning with the date on which the experimental Order comes into force or, if the Order is varied by subsequent Orders or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the date on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification comes into force. Any such objection or representation must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be emailed to: [parkingdesign@lewisham.gov.uk](mailto:parkingdesign@lewisham.gov.uk) or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, 1 st Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference 'Deptford Parks Liveable Neighbourhoods - ETO'. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
