Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Knowles Hill Crescent, SE13 and Cranfield Road SE4)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking in (i) the northern arm of Knowles Hill Crescent between Courthill Road and a point 30 meters west of Courthill Road; and (ii) Cranfield Road between Nos.31/33 & 47/49.
(2) The respective alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Courthill Road and the southern section of Knowles Hill Crescent and vice versa; and (ii) Brockley Road, Harefield Road and Wickham Road, and vice versa.
2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
3. The order comes into force on the 16th August 2021 to remain in force for up to 3 months.

(Note: Knowles Hill Crescent works are expected to be carried out between 16th and 20th August 2021 and the Cranfield Road works between 31st August and 6th September 2021.)

4. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
