ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (BLACKHEATH ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN AND PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on the A2 Blackheath Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right into Blackheath Road from Greenwich South Street.
 - (2) stopping on the eastbound carriageway of Blackheath Road between No.77A Blackheath Road and its junction with Greenwich South Street.

The Order will be effective from 8:00 AM on the 28th August 2021 until 5:00 PM on the 30th August 2021 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Blackheath Hill, Shooters Hill, A2 Rochester Way, Kidbrooke Park Road, Eltham Road, Lee High Road, Lewisham High Street and Lewisham Road to normal route of travel.
