ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (LONG ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water main leak repair works on the A3 Long Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on the eastbound carriageway of the A3 Long Road between its junctions with The Pavement and Rookery Road. The Order will be effective at certain times from 11:00 PM on the 20th August 2021 until 05:00 AM on the 27th August 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Rookery Road, Clapham Common North Side and The Pavement to normal route of travel.
