ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named, Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecom cabling works to take place on A23 Streatham High Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except pedal cycles from proceeding along the northbound carriageway of Streatham High Road at its junctions between Drewstead Road and Sternhold Avenue.

 The Order will be effective between 16th August 2021 and 18th August

The Order will be effective between 16th August 2021 and 18th August 2021 every night 10:30 PM to 4:30 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Drewstead Road, Railway Bridge and Sternhold Avenue to normal route of travel
