## VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR FILMING IN BISHOP'S TERRACE, OAKDEN STREET, ST MARY'S GARDENS AND ST MARY'S WALK 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take

- place in Bishop's Terrace, Oakden Street, St Marv's Gardens and St Mary's Walk, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be at certain times to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:-
  - (a) Bishop's Terrace: (b) that length of Oakden Street which lies between Bishop's Terrace and Nos. 9 and 10 Oakden Street:
  - (c) St Mary's Gardens; and

by the road closures described above would be available

- (d) St Mary's Walk.
- Alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicles affected
- via Monkton Street, Sullivan Road, Walcot Square and Kennington Road and vice versa. (In practice it is anticipated that filming would be intermittent, so pedestrian access to and from premises in the above roads would be maintained outside filming) 3. The bans would only have effect at such times and to
- such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and they would not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the filming.
- The Order would come into force on 14th September 2021 and continue for a maximum duration of 3 days or until the filming is completed whichever is the sooner.
