TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS WORKS BURNBURY ROAD.

FIELDHOUSE ROAD, GLENFIELD ROAD, HAVERHILL ROAD AND RADBOURNE ROAD

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to modernise telecommunications equipment to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have
- made an Order the effect of which wil be to temporarily impose a one-way system in:-(a) Burnbury Road, between Telferscot Road and
 - Haverhill Road, in a south-westward direction: (b) Fieldhouse Road, the whole length in a north-
 - westward direction: (c) Glenfield Road, the whole length, in a north-
 - westward direction: (d) Haverhill Road, between Emmanuel Road and
 - Burnbury Road, in a north-westward direction: (e) Radbourne Road, between Emmanuel Road and Burnbury Road, in a south-eastward direction.
- Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the restrictions described in paragraph 1 above, via
- adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs. 3. The one-way systems described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order will come into force on 6th September 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the one-way systems will only apply in phases as the works progress along the roads concerned and it is anticipated that the

works will take between 2 and 3 weeks to complete in
