The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to provide a new ‘short stay’ disabled blue badge holder’s parking place in the north-east side of Courthill Road, 6.6 metres in length, extending north-westward from a point 5.5 metres north-west of the north-western wall of No. 1 Courthill Road, removing an existing limited waiting place and ‘single yellow line’ at this location. Vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons blue badge may be left in the new parking place for a maximum stay of up to 20 minutes at any time, provided no vehicle may return within 2 hours.

Any objection or other representations relating to the proposed Orders must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be emailed to: highways@lewisham.gov.uk or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, Fifth Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference ‘Courthill Road Disabled Parking TMO’ to arrive not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this notice. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
