- access road to 1-127 Winchfield Road; (ii) Trim Street, between Arklow Road and the projected common boundary of Nos.5 & 6 Trim Street: (iii) Arklow Road, between Edward Street and the projected northwestern kerb of Trim Street (Note: Closures will only be for a few days at a time for either sewer connection works or crane operations.)
- No parking/waiting at any time in (i) Fairlawn Park, between Sydenham Road and Winchfield Road (adjacent to Nos. 138-188, 85-115 & 2-14): (ii) Winchfield Road, from Fairlawn Park for a distance of 180 meters eastwards: (iii) the access road to property Nos. 1-127 Winchfield Road: (iv) Arklow Road: between Edward Street and the projected common boundary of Nos.24 & 26 Arklow Road: (v) Edward Street, between the projected southwestern building line of No.4 Kerry Road and Amersham Grove; (vi) Idonia Street; (vii) Payne Street; and (viii) Watson's Street. (Note: Parking prohibitions are expected to be for a period of 5 to 8 weeks to allow oversize vehicles to access the works. Affected residents will be given prior notice of these dates.)
- 3. Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer 4. The order is intended to come into force on the 4th October 2021
- to remain in force for up to 12 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner. 5. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the
