THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 AND A202 GLA ROADS AND SIDE ROADS (MILLBANK, GROSVENOR ROAD, CHELSEA EMBANKMENT AND BESSBOROUGH GARDENS, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND THE ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) TRAFFIC ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under sections 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order would be to impose a speed limit of 20 MPH on the A3212 GLA Roads – Grosvenor Road/ Millbank and Victoria Embankment and A202 Bessborough Gardens and Vauxhall Bridge and all GLA Side Roads – Red Route returns of these roads in The City of Westminster and Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
3. The roads which would be affected by the Order are GLA Main Roads and all GLA Side Roads – Red Route returns of these roads as listed in article 2 above.
4. The roads affected are currently subject to a permanent speed limit of 30 MPH.
5.
