 - (iii) Fitzpatrick Road:
 - (iv) Navarre Road: and
 - (v) Winterslow Road: and (b) temporarily suspend the point of no entry from

Cromwell Road to Navarre Road.

2. Alternative routes will be available for affected vehicles

via (i) Cromwell Road, Patmos Road, Fredrick Crescent,

Elliott Road, Cancell Road, Eythorne Road, Cromwell

Road, Navarre Roaed, Winterslow Road, Cromwell Road and vice versa; and (ii) Evthorne Road. Akerman Road.

Patmos Road and vice versa 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent

as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that not all roads will be closed at the same time and some of the works will be carried out overnight.

The Order will come into force on 18th October 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to

allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 18th October 2021 and 30th May 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the
