temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of crane operations on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order shall be as indicated below.

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Marischal Road, SE13 between the projected northern kerbline of Lee High Road (at the western extents of Marischal Road) and the projected common (rear) boundary to Nos. 37 and 39 Lee High Road. (Note, in effect this is the one way section of Marischal Road) (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition shall be via Lee High Road and Marischal Road, and vice versa.
- 2. The current one way working in Marischal Road shall be suspended during the works to allow access and egress.
- Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- **4.** The order is intended to come into force on the 1st November to remain in force for up to 5 months.
- (Note: Closures are planned to take place on 3 days only, 7th December 2021, 11th January and 1st February 2022)
