## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (ATLANTIC ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable railway bridge inspection works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or
- exiting Atlantic Road at its junction with A23 Brixton Road. The Order will be effective at certain times between 2nd November 2021 and 4th November 2021, every night 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs (for traffic wishing to exit Atlantic Road) via Coldharbour Lane. Brixton Road. Effra Road. St Matthew's Road and Brixton Hill to normal route of travel. For traffic wishing to turn into

Atlantic Road) via Coldharbour Lane to normal route of travel.
