ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place on the A2 New Cross Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning right from Watson's Street into New Cross Road;
 - (2) turning right from Florence Road into New Cross Road;

(3) turning right from New Cross Road eastbound into Florence Road. The Order will be effective at certain times between 23rd October 2021 and 31st October every Saturday 8:00 AM until Sunday 5:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs. Eastbound traffic via New Cross Road eastbound, Deptford Church Street northbound, roundabout Deptford Church Street/Creekside, Deptford Church Street southbound and New Cross Road westbound to normal route of travel. Westbound traffic via New Cross Road westbound. Amersham Road, Parkfield, Lewisham
