ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (CAVENDISH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on the A205 Cavendish Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, proceeding or stopping on Cavendish Road southbound between its junction with Poynders Road and No. 75 Cavendish Road;

- (2) turning left into Cavendish Road from Poynders Road.

The Order will be effective from 10:00 AM on 8th November 2021 until 5:00 PM on 12th November 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs (for vehicles travelling southbound) via Poynders Road, Rudloe Road and Honeybrook Road to normal route of travel. For vehicles wishing to turn left into Cavendish Road via Rudloe Road and Honeybrook Road to normal route of travel.
