ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (OLD KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane installation works to take place on the A2 Old Kent Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, except pedal cycles from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Old Kent Road between its junctions with Hyndman Street and Devon Street.
The Order will also suspend the westbound bus lane on Old Kent Road, between its junctions with Ethnard Road and Commercial Way.
Pedestrians will be diverted by the southern footway between Hyndman Street and Devon Street.
Access will be maintained to KFC and Kwik Fit.
Marshals will be onsite to assist with pedestrians and cyclists diversions.
The Order will be effective between 7th January 2022 and 10th January 2022, 21st January 2022 and 24th January 2022, 18th February 2022 and 21st February 2022, 4th March 2022 and 7th March 2022, 18th March 2022 and 21st March 2022 every Friday at 11:00 PM until Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: St James Road, Rotherhithe New Road, Ilderton Road and reverse to normal route of travel.
