ban vehicles from entering that section of Honeybrook Road between the south-eastern kerb-line of Cavendish Road and the north-western wall of No. 147 Cavendish Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Honeybrook Road, Poynders Road and Cavendish Road. 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such

extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 21st January 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between

21st January 2022 and 7th February 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
