## LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - VIRGIL STREET 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water

chamber repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Virgil Street.

2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

available via (i) Hercules Road, Cosser Street, Kennington Road, Lambeth Road, Hercules Road and Carlisle Lane; and (ii) Carlisle Lane, Centaur Street and Hercules Road. and Carlisle Lane.

4. The Order would come into force on 28th January 2022

A. The Order would come into force on 28th January 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 28th January 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration

of 1 month.
