## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Mayow Road, SE26) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary

traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Mayow Road, SE26 between Queenswood Road and Adamsril. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected are via either (i) Queenswood Road, Perry Rise, Bell Green, Sydenham Road and Mayow Road, or (ii) Adamsril Road, Perry Rise, Perry Vale and Mayow Road, or (iii) Perry Vale, Perry Rise, Bell Green, Mayow Road, and vice versa.

Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 10th January 2022 to remain in force for up to 10 months. (Note: The following closures are expected:- (i) 10 days in January for sewer connections works; (ii) 2 days in July for crane dismantling works;

and (iii) 2 days in September to remove the site accommodation units using a mobile crane.) 4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
