ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A501 GLA SIDE ROAD (PARK CRESCENT, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- Order is summarised in paragraph 3.2. The purpose of the Order is to enable signal modernisation works to take place on the Park Crescent (western arm) at its junction with Marylebone Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering Park Crescent (western arm) at its junction with Marylebone Road.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 15th January 2022 and 19th January 2022, every night 9:00 PM until 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for
- London.

 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Marylebone Road eastbound, Albany Street, Osnaburgh Terrace, Osnaburgh Street, Great Portland Street and

Marylebone Road to normal route of travel.
