ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A4 GLA ROAD (KNIGHTSBRIDGE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster and Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place on the A4 Knightsbridge.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on Knightsbridge westbound between its junctions with Grosvenor Place and Seville Street, local access will be maintained between Grosvenor Place and Wilton Place;
 - (2) entering or proceeding in Piccadilly Underpass westbound between its junctions with the Piccadilly slip road to Hyde Park Corner and Knightsbridge;
 - (3) stopping on both carriageways of Knightsbridge between its junctions with Wilton Place and William Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 25th April 2022 and 4th May 2022 every Monday and Tuesday night 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Hyde Park Corner, Duke of Wellington Place, Grosvenor Place southbound, Lower Grosvenor Place, Buckingham Palace Road, Pimlico Road, Lower Sloane Street, Sloane Square and Sloane Street to normal route of travel.
