LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – BONDWAY AND MILES STREET 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable highway

- works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily –

 (a) ban vehicles from entering **Bondway**; and
 - (b) ban vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in **Miles**

Street between Wandsworth Road and the northwestern kerb-line of Bondway.

- 2. Whenever the above road closure applies the one-way system in:-
 - (a) Bondway; and
 - (b) Miles Street between Wandsworth Road and the north-western kerb-line of Bondway,

would be suspended, so as to allow vehicles access and egress to properties and premises, providing that vehicle does not interfere with or disrupt the works.

3. The above road closure and suspensions would only

- apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- A. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Parry Street, Wandsworth Road and Miles Street.
- 5. The Order would come into force on 30th May 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 30th May until 1st July 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days

within the maximum duration of 2 months. **Dated 13th May 2022**
