

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH

PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE A LOADING PLACE AND INTRODUCE A LENGTH OF SINGLE YELLOW LINE IN PALACE ROAD

[NOTE: This notice is about proposals to provide a new loading place and to introduce a length of single yellow which would operate between the hours specified below in Palace Road. Objections or other comments may be made – see paragraph 6.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Loading Place) (No. -) Order 202*- and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. ***) Order 202* under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) provide a new loading place on the north-east side of Palace Road opposite the Palace Road Nature Garden, 15.8 metres south-east of Coburg Crescent (the loading place would be 15.1 metres long, it would operate every day between 7 am and 6 pm for periods of up to 20 minutes with no return to the loading place within 1 hour, only vehicles that are being continually loaded or unloaded would be permitted to use the loading place); and
- (b) introduce at a length of single yellow line in that length of Palace Road which lies on the north-east side (adjacent to the new loading place) between a point 30.9 metres south-east of Coburg Crescent and a point 50.9 metres south-east of Coburg Crescent which would operate between 7 am and 7 pm Monday to Fridays inclusive.

3. The proposed Orders are necessary to provide loading and unloading facilities for vehicles making deliveries to or collections from nearby properties and premises.
