2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 16th May 2022 to remain in force

for up to 1 month.
(Note: Works are planned to be completed by 27th May 2022.)

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
