ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3212 GLA ROAD (CHELSEA EMBANKMENT, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A3212 Chelsea Embankment.
3. The effect of the Order will permit all vehicles proceeding on Chelsea Embankment westbound to turn right into Beaufort Street northbound. The Order will be effective at certain times between 12:01 AM on 7th May 2022 and 6:00 AM on 7th July 2022 every night 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
