ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable scaffolding works to take place on the A3200 Southwark Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, except pedal cycles, to turn right from Stamford Street / Blackfriars Road into
 - Southwark Street.

 Pedestrian diversions will be in place during the works.
- The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on 21st May 2022 and 6:00 PM on 22nd May 2022, and between 8:00 AM on 28th May 2022 and 6:00 PM on 29th May 2022 or when the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police

(I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire

- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Webber Street, Surrey Row, Union Street, Scoresby Street, Nicholson Street and Burrell Street and then to normal
 - route of travel.
