in Bankton Road, extend the existing residents parking place on the south-east side, adjacent to No. 20 Talma Road in place of the single y

(d) in Brockwell Park Gardens, reduce the free parking place on the north-west side, opposite No. 47 and replace with double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions; in Daysbrook Road, provide 3 doctors parking places on the north-west side, near to its junction with Palace Road and shorten the existing (e)

in **Daysbrook Road**, provide 3 doctors parking places on the north-west side, near to its janston. The shared use parking place; in **Flaxman Road**, reduce the existing residents parking bays on the north-west side adjacent to Odin House and Baltic House and introduce double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions; in **Helix Road**, extend the existing residents parking place outside No. 94 in place of the single yellow line; in **Herne Hill Road**, replace the existing shared use parking bay adjacent to No. 207b Coldharbour Lane with double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions in Heron Road, reduce the shared use parking place on the north-east side by 7.7 metres and the shared use parking place on the south-(i)

side by 10.4 metres and replace with double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions; in **Holmewood Gardens**, on the east side, replace 25 metres of double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions with a residents parking place at its junction with Holmewood Road;

in Hydethorpe Road, on the north-west side, provide a car club parking place adjacent to Nos. 32 to 36 Primrose Court; in Jonathan Street: (i)introduce 2 doctors parking places on the north-east side, outside the Vauxhall Surgery, No. 8 Jonathan Street; and (ii) upgrade the existing single yellow line waiting restrictions on the north-east side outside the Vauxhall Surgery, No. 8 Jonathan Street and opposite Wickham Street, and the south-west side opposite the Vauxhall Surgery, No. 8 Jonathan Street to double yellow line waiting restrictions that will operate "at any time;

(m) in Killieser Avenue, split the existing shared use parking place outside No. 18 and replace with single yellow line;

in Parkthorne Road, on the south-east side, extend the residents parking place adjacent to No. 53 Thornton Road; in Rectory Gardens, introduce a restricted parking zone, where vehicles will be banned from waiting at any time; in Rodenhurst Road, reduce the residents parking place outside Nos. 45 and 47 and replace with single yellow line;

(y) in Talma Road, on the south-west side, to extend the disabled parking place outside No. 12 and extend the adjacent residents parking place;
(z) in The Chase, (i) on the north-east side, extend the existing residents parking place opposite Nos. 109 and 111 in place of the single yellow line; and (ii) on the south-west side, reduce the existing shared use parking place outside No. 95 and replace with single yellow line; and iii northon Road, (i) both sides, extend the residents parking places outside Nos. 41 and 43; (ii) the north-east side, provide additional residents parking places, outside No. 55 and Nos. 59 and 61; (iii) the south-west side, extend the residents parking places opposite No. 55; and (iv) the south-west side, extend the residents parking places, opposite No. 63;
(bb) in Upper Tulse Hill, on the south-west side, replace 15 metres of shared use parking place with double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions at its junction with Brixton Hill;
(cc) in Yauxhall Walk, introduce; (i) on the east side, double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions outside Nos. 15 to 21, a shared use parking

at its junction with Brixton Hill; in **Vauxhall Walk**, introduce: (i) on the east side, double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions outside Nos. 15 to 21, a shared use parking bay (permit holders, pay by phone) outside Nos. 11 and 13 and a shared use parking bay (permit holders, pay by phone, business) opposite Nos. 92 to 98 Spring News; and (ii) on the west side, double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions between No. 21 and Randall Row, between No. 3 Citadel Place and Tinworth Street, between Nos. 92 to 98 Spring Mews and No. 104 Vauxhall Walk; in **Waterloo Bridge**, convert the single yellow line waiting restrictions on the north-west, south-west and north-east sides of the south-eastern island located opposite the south-eastern end of Whitehouse Apartments and outside Kings College London; in **Weir Road**, on the south-east side, reduce the shared use parking place outside No. 216 and replace with double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions;

(ff) introduce a Restricted Parking Zone in **Rectory Gardens**; and (gg) make certain other amendments so as bring the Orders in line with the on street layout.

3. The Orders are necessary to improve junction safety and visibility for all road users, improve traffic flow, maintain safe cycle and pedestrian accesses, provide extra parking bays for disabled persons, doctors and car clubs and prevent unsafe parking.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
