SCHOOL STREETS – INDEFINITE CONTINUATION OF (COVID-19) TEMPORARY MEASURES

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (School Streets) (No. 9) Traffic Order 2022

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 22 nd August 2022 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers of sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (‘the 1984 Act’). The Order will come into force on 30th August 2022.

2. The general effect of the Order will be, to continue indefinitely certain measures introduced by temporary traffic orders under section 14 of the 1984 Act, to:

(a) provide ‘pedestrian and cycle zones’ in the vicinity of: ATHELNEY PRIMARY SCHOOL, BRINDISHE GREEN PRIMARY SCHOOL, COOPERS LANE PRIMARY SCHOOL, HASELTINE PRIMARY SCHOOL, HOLBEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL, KILMORIE PRIMARY SCHOOL, LUCAS VALE PRIMARY SCHOOL, MYATT GARDEN PRIMARY SCHOOL, and ST. JOHN BAPTIST (SOUTHEND) CE PRIMARY SCHOOL, comprising the streets or parts of streets listed in column (2) of Schedule 1 to this Notice. The pedestrian and cycle zones will operate at the times listed in column (3) of Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) prohibit vehicles, except pedal cycles proceeding through a ‘pedal cycle gap’ provided, proceeding in the roads or parts of roads listed in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this Notice from entering into the roads or parts of roads listed in column (2) of Schedule 2; and

(c) reinstate two-way traffic working for pedal cycles in BEACON ROAD between its junctions with Hither Green Lane and Ardmere Road (that length remaining one-way north- eastbound for vehicles other than pedal cycles).

3. All motor vehicles except permit holders will be prohibited from entering each pedestrian and cycle zones during the hours of operation. Permits allowing vehicles to enter the zones will be available to residents of premises located within or only accessible from a pedestrian and cycle zone, and to disabled person’s badge holders who are school staff or carers or have a bona fide reason to enter or leave a vehicle in a pedestrian and cycle zone, by application to the Council. Any vehicle that is already within a pedestrian and cycle zone prior to its commencement of operation will be permitted to leave. Exemptions will apply in respect of emergency service vehicles and certain Council services.

4. The Order is intended to create a pleasant environment that feels safer in the immediate vicinity of a school, discourage travelling to school by car, and encourage walking, scooting and cycling to school, thereby achieving positive health outcomes for the school community. These measures are being continued indefinitely following the lifting of Covid-19 social distancing restrictions having been deemed effective during the trial period.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
