ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANES) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable chamber installation works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicle bay outside Nos.381 to 391 Brixton Road;

The Order will also:

- (2) allow all vehicles to use the southbound bus lane on Brixton Road between its junctions with Gresham Road and Tunstall Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 13th August 2022 and 25th September 2022, every Saturday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 4:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
