ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (OLD KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water main repair works to take place on the A2 Old Kent Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right from Old Kent Road south-eastbound into Albany Road;
 - (2) turning right from Albany Road into Old Kent Road south-eastbound;
 - (3) proceeding ahead from Humphrey Street into Albany Road;
 - (4) stopping on Humphrey Street between its junction with Old Kent Road and a point 50 metres north-eastwards (Red Route return).The Order will be effective at certain times between 12th August 2022 and 27th August 2022, every Friday at 10:00 PM until Saturday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Old Kent Road, New Cross Road, Amersham Road, Parkfield Road, Lewisham Way, New Cross Road and Old Kent Road to normal route of travel.
