ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (SUDBOURNE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH

OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the

above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic

- Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable construction works to take place
- near the A23 GLA Side Road Sudbourne Road.

 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in
 - the Parking and Disabled persons' vehicles Bay on Sudbourne Road opposite Effra Court, No. 12 Brixton Hill.

 The Order will be effective between 12.01 AM on 4th October 2022 and 11.59 PM on 31st December 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police.
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
