VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR FILMING IN ALASKA STREET, BRAD STREET, CORNWALL ROAD, ROUPELL STREET AND WINDMILL WALK 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable filming to take

place in Alaska Street, Brad Street, Cornwall Road, Roupell Street and Windmill Walk the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:
(a) ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering:-

- (i) Alaska Street, the whole length;
- (ii) Brad Street, so much as is public highway;
 (iii) Cornwall Road, between Roupell Street and
- (iii) Cornwall Hoad, between Houpell Street an Sandell Street;
 - (iv) Roupell Street, between Cornwall Road and
 - Theed Street;
 (v) Windmill Walk, between Roupell Street and
 - Wootton Street;
- (b) ban vehicles proceeding in:-
 - (i) Waterloo Road from entering Alaska Street;
 (ii) Roupell Street from turning left into Cornwall
- Road; and
 (iii) Exton Street from turning right into Cornwall
- Road.

 2. Alternative routes for vehicles and pedestrians affected

by the road closures described above will be available via adjacent streets as directed by traffic signs. (In practice it is anticipated that filming will be intermittent,

- so pedestrian access to and from premises in the above roads will be maintained outside filming)

 3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1(a)(iv)
- applies the one-way systems for vehicles in Roupell Street will be suspended.

 4. The bans willonly have effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the
- 4. The bans willonly have effect at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs and they will not apply to any vehicle or person connected with the filming.
 5. The Order will come into force on 12th October 2022

and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 7
